



"IN SPITE of Barney, I think I'm still pretty well known to the public as Don Knotts," he says. "But being so completely identified with a part often works against an actor and I want to avoid that trap."

Knotts has ambitious and diverse plans for his career and, while he intends to remain primarily with the comedy he knows and does so well, he eventually hopes to broaden the scope of his acting talents.

In fact, he has a secret ambition to play a role one day which is about as far from the public image of Don Knotts as one can get.

"Yep," he said, stretching his frail, 120-pound frame to its full height. "I'd like to play the roughest, toughest villain you ever saw."
