

It seems as tho we answer this question every month! And the answer is still the same... "Gone with the Wind" has never been on TV!

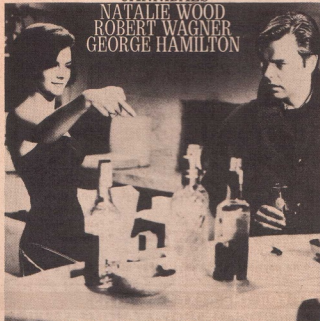

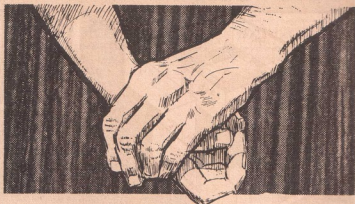

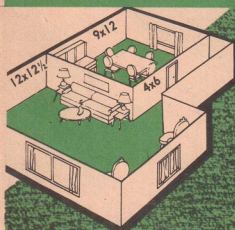
