

AT 15, she won \$15,000 on Name That Tune, then went on to star in Mitch Miller's Sing Along with Mitch television series. Afterward she went on to sing in virtually every top night spot from coast-to-coast, and doing guest appearances on the major musical TV varlety shows. WALLY COX discovered the value of humor early in life.

"I was the smallest kid in the class," he said. "I had a high-pitched voice, good diction, good marks and the teachers liked me. I was a perfect subject for getting method woredy I could give correct answers and make the kids laugh, without offending the teacher. I had to dance between eggs."

Wally likes to laugh.

"TD rather' laugh then do anything else," he said. "I find inanimate objects territyly amusing, one of the hardest and most memorable laughs I've had involved watching a garden hose emerging from a swimmig pool with water turned on full pressure. The hose lashed about like an angry serpent dashing its head on the cement."

Wally's whimiscal sense of

Waily's whimsical sense of humor has made TV fans laugh from the days of Mr. Peepers to Wally's current stint as a regular panelist on The Hollywood Squares, daytime and nighttime color series on NBC-TV.

Wally knows what makes people laugh but not why they laugh.

"EVERY time I've contemplated a definition of humor I've found it wanting;" he said. "I don't want to define humor. I don't think it can be defined. WALLY cited as an example his father's sense of humor: "He liked to answer signs. When he saw a sign in a hotel that said, 'Stop, Have You Forgotten Anything?' he said, 'I won't know until I get

Wally, whose interests include nature, electronics, sculpture, history, music, politics, economics, sociology, anthropology and handicrafts, among others, is currently preoccupied with the study of semantics—the study of the meaning of words. "I'VE only recently become aware that this is what I've been searching for," said Wally. "It's so orienting to me. I know what I think afterwards. I feel semantics is the key to mental health and therefore to most human ills. including war."

The fact that Wally looks hopefully at the world constitutes a good clew to his attitude toward humor.

"I SEE so much progress, despite the troubles in the world," he said. "I believe that Freud was right when he said, We may say that the voice of reason is small and weak compared to the voice of instinct, and we will be right. But the voice of intelligence will not stop until it is heard."


