IN NOVEMBER of last year Troy Donahue and his wife, Valerie Allen, walked out on their contract with Pheasant Run Playhouse just before opening night. What was the amount asked, and the amount awarded in the suit filed by Pheasant Run against them? Also, were they divorced since then?—Mrs. E. S. P., Winfield.

Carl Stohn Jr., producer at Pheasant Run Playhouse, told us they sued Donahue and his wife, Valerie, for \$200,000 for walking out on their contract two days before they were to have opened in "Poor Richard." The case is still

pending, but since then "Poor Troy" declared bankruptcy. In February Mr. Donahue was assessed \$100,000 damages in Circuit court for inducing Valerie to break the contract—however, there is no record of a settlement with her either. In April Valerie sued for divorce, charging "extreme cruelty."

My jealous girlfriend claims Claudia Cardinale was involved in a scandal a few years ago. My opinion wouldn't change—scandal or no scandal—because I think she's great. I was wondering if you could tell me just what kind of scandal she's talking about—Claude G., Chicago.







Peapicker in Piccadilly

A RIDE THRU London in a 1911 double-decker bus, a mini version of Gilbert and Sullivan's "H. M. S. Pinafore," and a visit to Westminster Abbey are among the highlights of The Peapicker in Piccadilly, the full-hour musical-variety special starring Tennessee Ernie Ford to be presented in color Monday on NBC-TV [9-10 p. m., Channel 5].

The program, prepared entirely in England, spotlights an all-British roster of guest stars: Davy Jones [of the Monkees], Actor-singer Harry Secombe, and Comedian Terry-Thomas. Another comedian, Norman Wisdom, appears in a cameo role, and the Ambrosian Boys choir is featured.

Ernie opens the show with his popular rendition of "Sixteen Tons" as the cameras focus on men working at the docks along the Thames and in other parts of London.

Ernie is joined by Secombe and Jones as he sings "London Is London" and "If I Ruled the World" in the studios of Associated Television Corporation Ltd. [ATV]. This is followed by Ernie singing "Nashville Is Nashville" while Terry-Thomas does a reprise of "London Is London."

"Consider Yourself" is the song offered

by Ernie, Jones and Secombe as the cast takes a tour of London in the 1911 open-topped bus. The Ambrosian Singers perform "Fill the World with Love" and Ernie sings "Where Did My Childhood Go?" at separate outdoor locales.


Next, there is a production number offering a condensed version of the Gilbert and Sullivan comic operetta "H. M. S. Pinafore," featuring the entire cast. Here, Wisdom makes his cameo appearance as Buttercup.

The picturesque village of Castle Combe is the locale as Ernie sings "The Green Green Grass of Home," "Little Green Apples," "Dear World," and "Country Pie." Jones sings "Scarborough Fair."

The finale, with Ernie and the entire cast on the studio stage, offers "When Johnny Comes Marching Home" and "Battle Hymn of the Republic" sung by Ernie and the Ambrosian Boys choir.

During the latter song, the scene shifts to show Ernie walking down the aisle of Westminster Abbey.

The Peapicker in Piccadilly was produced by BetFord Corporation in association with ATV and the NBC Television Network. Digby Wolfe and Bob Wynn are the co-producers.


Also on channel 9 at 4:30 p. m. is another Thanksgiving Day special, A Light Here Kindled, the story of the Pilgrims.




