The 'Mark Twain' of TV

Steinberg on rapping, Fem Lib and ratings

YOU just have to like a performer who, when discussing women's liberation, observes: "If all this liberation is in some way going to ruin the King Family, then it's just not worth it."

When once asked by an interviewer if he likes to "rap," he replied: "Rap? No, I never rap. I talk once in a while, but I never rap."

The source of these remarks is, indeed, one of the most likable persons in show business today: good old, 29-year-old David Steinberg, Canadian-born humorist, actor, writer, occasional host for such video programs as Johnny Carson's Tonight Show, creator of masterfully witty monologues based on the Bible (and praised by clergymen), Elektra recording star, and zany intelligent descendant of the Marx Brothers school of comedy.

LIKE ANY reasonable person,

Steinberg finds things to criticize about television. But he is refreshingly positive about the home medium's better offerings, and has little patience with the snobism and phony sophistication of persons who think it's chic not to watch video.

"Some movie stars go on talk shows unprepared," he said over a cup of tea in his room at the Beverly-Wilshire Hotel during a visit to Hollywood. "It's simply a lack of awareness on their part. They don't understand that more people see them in that one appearance than may ever see them in their hottest movie."

Steinberg also differs from the view that young persons don't watch much television, and he offers some unique reasoning:

"Young people do watch, but they don't constitute an audience that can be rated. There's a whole generation on the street — or at college, where they don't own sets, so they're not rated."

STEINBERG, a slight, darkly handsome fellow with a warm personal manner, agrees with communications theorist Marshall McLuhan that the medium is watched more than individual shows.

"The TV is left on," he said, "and

that means TV is the news and talk shows, even in their current framework. But young people watch Flip Wilson too, among others. And, among the talk shows, Carson specifically. You'd be given the impression that it's Dick Cavett, but it's Carson. Cavett has a pretense of intellect, but if he had a pretense of warmth, he'd break through. Carson is the best."

As for his own video future, Steinberg, whose new Elektra album is a delight, says that for this year he will be occupied mainly with a movie and twice-a-week college appearances, which he finds "very satisfactory" — but that NBC-TV has been discussing possible vehicles for him.

"They're talking a special," he said, "and I'm interested in that. They'd be interested in going any di-

rection. I prefer a variety series to a talk show. I figure that by 1984 or 1985 everyone in the United States will have his own talk show. You can open up in a comedy-variety program, be a fully rounded performer."

THOUGH HE has an obvious intellectual bent, Steinberg says: "Of course I have to be loyal to my point of view, but I want the hardhats to like me, too. Luckily, we're coming to a good time now — the networks are more and more aware of the demographics of the new audience."

What wouldn't he do on television? "A talk show," he said, "or a political show. I wouldn't use the networks to promote my own political point of view. Mine is a social viewpoint. I relate more to Mark Twain than anyone."
