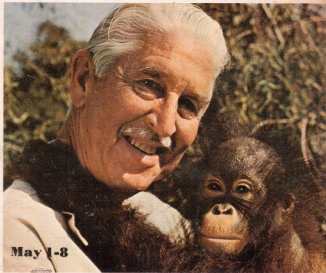

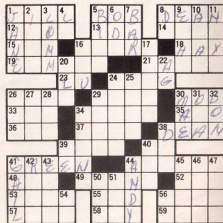

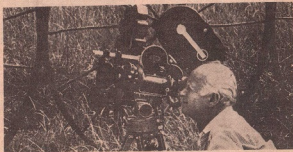

THURSDAY: Black Journal. 8 p.m. Channel 11 (WTTW). "Justice?" is the show WTTW almost didn't show because of its auction last week. Angela Davis and other black prisoners are considered in a one-hour program on how the law treats the black man.

Chicago's **Dave Garroway** is back disk-jockeying after an eight-year layoff from the Today Show, which he quit to do "some listening and looking and thinking." Now, says Dave, "the only thing I never want to do again is not work. When a man stops working, he stops functioning. So I'm available for anything." ... Dave told Cecil Smith how young Dave became 13 last Feb. 9, the morning of L.A.'s big earthquake. "See," Dave told his shaking son, "what being a teen-ager is like?"

● **IRONSIDE** producer Cy Chermak says he isn't at all nervous about the show being moved opposite *Mod Squad* next fall. "I think we'll win," he told *Variety*. "Every *Mod Squad* is the same. If you've seen one, you've seen them all. The ending is

so predictable. You know they will have the long shot pulling back as the tears are streaming down the girl's cheeks." On his show, he declares, "you never really know if it's going to be a love story, a detective story, or a locked-room mystery."

● **ARCHBISHOP Fulton J. Sheen** hopes to be back on national TV this

fall. "The beauties of television and the values of television have not yet been tapped," says the silver-haired prelate, who turns 76 this month. "Television is still the medium of the future." The archbishop contends that the nation is now looking for counseling and direction. "It is sick of forums, sick of discussions, and sick of dialog."

"The day of the indiscriminating mass movie audience has been superseded by multiple and separate audiences, which critically search for and demand films to suit their differing tastes."

● **DINAH SHORE** did a recent show with **Spiro Agnew**, Mrs. Agnew and their granddaughter, **Michelle**, 3. The Vice President couldn't have been more diplomatic at the taping, during which he helped prepare his favorite dish, linguine, played the piano, and answered Dinah's question whether he thought he played as well as **Harry Truman**. "I doubt it." Or as well as **President Nixon**? "Never," grinned Agnew. "Are you kidding?" By the way, Miss Shore shot the next show with **Archbishop Sheen**.

Violence doesn't bother Bob Stack

ROBERT STACK is a normally placid man. But mention television violence, and Bob loses his composure.

"I can't believe that anyone in his right mind believes that if a man shoots a gun at another man in a television drama that it will influence viewers to do the same thing.

"If someone hits Lucille Ball with a pie, does this trigger a series of pie-throwing incidents across the country?" Stack asked.

"It's the same way with movies and the rating system. Parents should be rated, not the producers, pictures or the entertainment industry.

"IF THERE is a family unit, the decision as to what should be seen must be determined by the head of the household.

"There is an empathy with action. And I don't use the word 'violence.' Action is a tremendous catharsis for frustrations and pressures in the audience."

Stack, who starred for years in The Untouchables and now in The Name of the Game, is accustomed professionally to action and strife.

"It's better to show the hero winning out over the villains than to take anti-heroes like the characters in 'Easy Rider' and show them in a sympathetic light.

"Peter Fonda played a dope pusher who represents everything reprehensible, immoral and illegal. But he was admired as a non-hero.

"It's oversimplification, but when you take a man who represents the worst of everything, it's a morally subversive thing to do. I thought 'Easy Rider' was a dangerous picture, more so than any violence on TV."

Stack also is bitter about the grow-

ing disparity of content in motion pictures and television action.

"Television is pabulum," he said, "while movies have gone overboard on murder and gore. The irony is that people think kids watch TV, not movies. Wrong. Kids get in to see those pictures one way or another.

"It's the ridiculous climate of the 'now.'" (UPI)
