**FRIDAY:** "Travis Logan, D.A." 8 p.m. Channel 2 (CBS). Vic Morrow prosecutes Hal Holbrook (formerly of The Senator), who breaks into an apartment, discovers his wife (Brenda Vaccaro) in a "tryst" (CBS publicity doesn't define exactly what that means), murders a man, pleads insanity and faces Morrow in court.

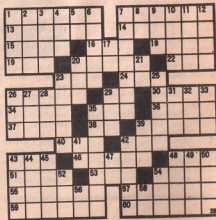

Does Howard Cosell have a sense of humor?

Could any series have been more misguided than the Don Knotts variety show, which took a funny fellow and made him nothing?

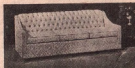
