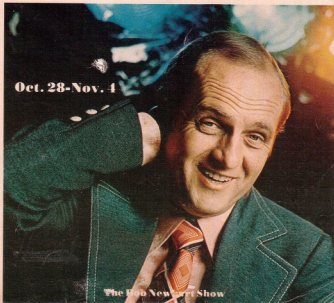

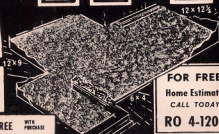

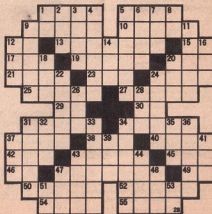

**TUESDAY: The Bold Ones.** 8 p.m. Channel 5 (NBC). The Bold Ones, which has been tastefully exploring new grounds this season, presents a drama in which a doctor attempts to renew his romance with a former girl friend, only to discover she is living with another woman in a lesbian relationship. **WEDNESDAY: "That Certain Summer."** 7:30 p.m. Channel 7 (ABC). This film, starring Hal Holbrook, may be the most talked about made-for-TV movie of the year. It is the story of a boy who searches for his father, who left home after a divorce. The boy finds his father, played by Holbrook, but the father is a homosexual.

Holbrook told me that this film "is not a tract, but in its own little way it creates an opportunity to observe a relationship with some intelligence and sympathy."

ABC executives are quietly, but forcefully, urging viewers to watch "That Certain Summer" and they are predicting it will have as much impact as last year's "Brian's Song."

**THURSDAY: "The Dirty Dozen."** 8 p.m. Channel 2 (CBS). Second part **FRIDAY at 8 p.m.** This is the second broadcast of a very violent movie that will certainly be found at the top of the ratings for the week. A group of misfits commanded by Lee Marvin is assigned to blow up a chateau behind German lines in World War II. They do it, but at the very end of Part II.

# Diahann Carroll yearns for her little house on the hill

**I**T WAS a dreary day in Manhattan, chilly and damp and gray. The view from Diahann Carroll's suite at the Regency Hotel on Park Av. was just as depressing. It was not one of the great New York views of skyscrapers glittering in the sun, ribbons of cars and terraced penthouses. It was, instead, a view of the backs of nondescript buildings and a shabby schoolyard.

"I'm liking New York less every time I come. I hate that sight out there. It makes me think of fire escapes and chipped paint and kitchens 100 years-old," Diahann said.

**SHE WAS** here to tape some of the songs she will sing on "Cole Porter in Paris," the musical special to be presented in January on NBC's Bell System Family Theater. She had just returned from Paris and Montreal, where other segments of the show were taped.

The special has all the signs of an engrossing 60 minutes. Perry Como is the host. Louis Jourdan and Connie Stevens are co-starring with Miss Carroll, and Martin Charmin, who had the idea for the show, is the co-director with Walter C. Miller.

**THE POTENTIALS** are those of a born winner — which can also be said of Diahann Carroll, the daughter of John Johnson, a former subway conductor, and his wife, Mabel, who now live in Westchester County. When she was growing up in the Bronx, Miss Carroll did not have to look far to see chipped paint, fire escapes and kitchens 100 years old. It was all right there.

"I'm aware of the necessity of cities," she said. "I like the vitality and excitement of cities, but only for a short while. I'm tired of traveling. I've been there. My God, I've been working since 1956. After a few weeks on tour, I start to sigh for my little house on the hill."

Her little house on the hill, which she bought from the late Lance Rev-



entlow, "looks like a ski lodge. It rambles, and it's all old brick and wood and beams, and there's a fantastic view out every window. I have to find a way to spend more time in that house."

**SHE WANTS** to work, but she wants work she can do from home. For this reason, she is going to concentrate more on recordings, which she can actually do better if she stays home.

Miss Carroll said the recording world has become so much a business of the artist and producer working closely together that it is essential that the artist stay put and not be out of reach, traveling around the country. She can also make TV guest appearances and still stay home.

Miss Carroll is the mother of a 12-year-old daughter, Suzanne, by her former marriage to Monte Kay, producer of the Flip Wilson show. They were divorced in 1964 after eight years of marriage.

She said Suzie feels sorry for her because she thinks her mother works too hard.

**SHE SAID** she has no plans to remarry. She and David Frost have been close friends for over two years, but she said, "I don't know whether or not we'll ever get married. I don't put that kind of onus on a man. I have enormous respect for David, and he has for me, which is far better than all those romantic notions we had of love when we were all much younger. Whatever happens, I think we'll have a lifetime friendship. He's a good, kind, intelligent man."

"I'm not that zippedy-do about marriage. I've been alone a long time. I've become quite secure with myself and I like to close the door and be alone. I like men very much, but I'm not dependent. Maybe that's one of the things David likes about me. He knows I'm not going to close in on him."

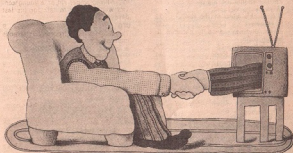

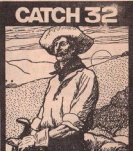
