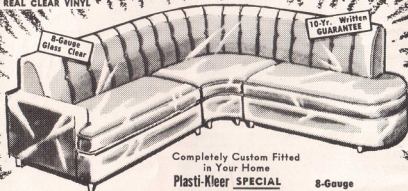

Ho Hum! Looks Like a Dull Summer

TWO THINGS are going to save television from incredible boredom this summer—coverage of political conventions and sports programming.

The convention telecasts probably will be the most exciting television of 1960 and the networks are working desperately to come up with new techniques.

One quick example—the increased use of videotape. The networks can tape highlights and save them for showing during those moments when the conventions get dull.

You don't need to be reminded how exciting sports telecasts can be, provided Chicago teams follow or improve the pattern of last summer.

I can shut my eyes now and recall vividly that wondrous scene on WGN-TV when Luis Aparicio scooped up a grounder, tapped second base, twisted and threw to first for the double play that clinched the American League pennant for the White Sox last year.

BUT LET'S take a look at the regular week in, week out, plans of the networks for summer programming.

The schedules still aren't completely

filled out but the general plan is clear enough. It's going to be pretty bad.

In previous summers, bad as they were, the networks would drop in a few live, variety shows here and there to break up the re-run parade.

Remember Steve Lawrence and Eydie Gorme, Andy Williams, Dave King and Janet Blair? They were summer stars.

But what's going to happen to the variety shows this time? Not much. Mostly the replacements will be filmed shows.

GARRY MOORE will take a vacation and will be replaced by new detective series.

Steve Allen will go off and be replaced by re-runs, probably repeats of the "Sunday Showcase" offerings. And Allen won't be back

next fall with a regular show. He'll be relegated to a few specials.

Pat Boone is another variety performer in trouble. Boone leaves to make way for repeats of "The Jeanne Carson Show" and, according to recent reports, is not yet definitely scheduled to return in the fall.

Earlier this spring, ABC-TV was talking about switching Pat from Thursday to Saturday nights next year, giving him an hour instead of just half an hour. But that talk died out. Recent "tentative" schedules don't list Boone at all.

PERRY COMO will take his annual vacation and will be replaced

by a couple of half-hour shows—a comedy and an action show.

The summer replacement for Dinah Shore hadn't been named at the time this was being written.

Ed Sullivan will continue through the summer and so will **Lawrence Welk**.

NBC-TV is planning to throw a new "music on ice" show against Sullivan on Sunday nights.

Here's the discouraging summary, though:

It looks as if only one-third of the evening programming this summer is going to be new. The other two-thirds will be repeats.

Producer Pierre Crenesse has endeavored to present "a picture of Paris as only a Frenchman, as only a person who is in love with this wonderful city, can."

PLAYS 400 CHARACTERS A WEEK

Allen Swift: He's Voice Of Television

By EARL WILSON

NEW YORK—Would you ever suspect that 400 different voices you hear in TV commercials in one week come out of one throat?

That's Allen Swift's estimate of the number of voice switches he does—and it may be low. When Arthur Godfrey was so hot, an ad agency had a prospective sponsor who wanted a sample commercial spoken by Godfrey—who was too busy.

"I did a sales pitch in Godfrey's voice—imitated Tony Marvin doing the commercials, too. The prospect bought it and never knew Godfrey didn't do it," Swift told me while sitting around Lindy's.

"Mickey Mantle, Dr. Cary Middlecoff and some other athletes photograph well on cigaret commercials, but didn't get enough 'sell' in," Swift said.

"I put a smile and a little more 'sell' in their voices—with their permission, of course."

* * *

ON AN NBC documentary several years ago, concerning the UN, Swift did the voices of F.D.R., Churchill and Harry Hopkins.

Swift, only 36, a boy from Washington Heights who moved to Brooklyn because he wanted to be a comedian, must be the most heard man on the air.

He does—in different voices—commercials for 5 cigarets, 9 gasolines, approximately 20 beers—and

"about a million soaps."

He started back in '53 by taking over Bob Smith's voice on "Howdy Doody" when Smith had a heart attack—also the voices of all 50 characters. He does Terry Tunes—and movie stars (such as David Niven who couldn't be in town to insert a line in "Happy Anniversary" a few months ago).

* * *

OF COURSE he's tempted to play pranks.

While in the Altitude Training Unit at Kingman, Ariz., he was pretty annoyed at a PX officer who'd been nasty to his wife, then working in the PX.

Swift got the idea of impersonating a famous loud, hot-tempered major. The major didn't know it—but he called the PX officer and chewed him out magnificently.

Swift's emcee of the Popeye the Sailor show in a sea-salt voice and also does one positively straight announcing job using his own voice.

"It sounds very strange to me," he admits.

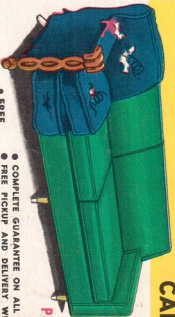
