## Prime-time special: The best of Royko

**T**HE humorous, poignant, hard-hitting and sometimes bittersweet columns cranked out 5 days a week for 7½ years by Mike Royko provide the script for Wednesday's NBC-TV prime-time special "Royko At Best." The hour-long program, which gets under way at 9 p.m., has been in the works since late August.

It will be The Chicago Daily News columnist's second major telecast in four years.

Royko, who describes the special as an "entertainment" type of program, will appear only in still photographs at the beginning and end of the show.

**PRODUCER** Scott Craig selected 12 columns for their variety of subject matter running from humor to pathos. A cast of 13 Chicagoans, in a series of vignettes, will animate "A Hero's Welcome," "Vogue On Clout," "Love Me, Love My Rock," "A Pilgrim Eyes Progress," "Constructive Chaos" and others.

In June, 1966, Royko's writing formed the backdrop for a half-hour special on ABC-TV. He has substituted for Marty Faye on WCIU-TV and Irv Kupcinet on ABC-TV. Currently, Royko is a regular panelist on ABC-TV's City Desk.

Royko, 37, has gained national exposure through two books—compilations of his most noteworthy columns—"Up Against It" and "I May Be

Wrong But I Doubt It." Time Magazine has featured him as the subject of a lead article in its press section and ChicagoLand Omnibus magazine called him "the hottest columnist in town."

Last year the Jaycees named Royko "Chicagoan of the Year" in their communications category. He also received the 1969 Heywood Broun Award from the American Newspaper Guild for his "sardonic, bold and courageous writing, always stressing the little man and what our society does to him."

## 'Harry and Lena': Special kind of special

THERE is a special kind of special Sunday night, "Harry and Lena," the first appearance together on television of Harry Belafonte and Lena Horne, 7 to 8 p.m., ABC-TV. When Belafonte was offered this show, he was given complete freedom to do with it what he wanted. All he wanted was Lena Horne.

He chose wisely. Lena Horne is one of a kind, one of the best of the women singers—certainly the most beautiful, distinct of style and manner, a performer polished to a high shine. She is much imitated, but nobody comes close.

During a lunch break in rehearsal for the special, in a big, bare room on New York's West 57th St., Belafonte went out to eat. Miss Horne stayed in and had a cup of soup. She said she works so hard during rehearsals, and gets so ruffled and sweaty, she likes to stay out of public sight. She didn't look ruffled and sweaty. She looked great.

SHE IS A warm woman, with a wide, friendly smile, disarmingly natural, direct, no evasions, no coyness, no effusions. She has made good use of every one of her giant steps to giant success, starting with her days as a chorus girl on the stage, then as a young singer at Harlem's Cotton Club, when Duke Elling-

ton was the king there, in the '30s. She has made equally good use of the cruel attachments to success.

"My fight is still to be graceful under pressure," she said. "I'm much better at it than I used to be. I don't mean I believe in turning the other cheek, but I used to make myself ill over every injustice, small and large. You have to keep fighting in whatever ways are open to you, but you do no good if you incapacitate yourself and drain all the joy out of living.

"Being a black woman has given me an extra dimension, more understanding. I've developed personal strengths I didn't know I had. I've been lucky to have some good, strong people around me, like my manager and my arranger, who've protected me from a lot of the abrasiveness of this business. I'm not sure, but I don't think I'm a natural born competitor. I hate to cook, but I sure do love to be home."

LENA HORNE describes herself as a "nesty" person, who prefers to be with her own family more than anybody else. "If someone drags me out to a party, I stand in a corner and watch everybody else being groovy. I'm very shy."

She has been married for 22 years to Lennie Hayton, the musician and

composer, and has two married children—a son, Ted, and a daughter, Gail, by an early first marriage. Ted, who has nephritis and has had both kidneys removed, lives with the help of a miraculous medical machine his mother has been able to buy for him.

She makes no big thing of this. She turns it into a brave little joke.

"Ted's machine keeps me working. Otherwise, I might get lazy and just sit around and get fat. We were so lucky to be able to buy one. There aren't enough to go around. At the hospitals, people are waiting in line for them."

Ted lives in Los Angeles, where he writes and teaches Spanish to adults

in a poverty program. He is divorced and has twin sons. Miss Horne's daughter, Gail, a graduate of Radcliffe, is married to Sidney Lumet, the producer, who was previously married to Gloria Vanderbilt. They have two daughters, Amy, 5, and Jenny, 3, and have an apartment in Manhattan. Miss Horne also keeps a small apartment in New York and has a house in Palm Springs.

"I'm a grandma four times, and I love it," she said. "That's what the kids call me, grandma, nothing fancy. I dig it. I'm so happy about my son-in-law and I wasn't at all when they first got married. I thought nobody was good enough for her. Lennie felt the same, but naturally, they didn't pay any attention to me and Lennie.

"**I RESPECT** a man who is decent to a woman, and he makes her very happy. He is so loving and kind. That's why I love him. He's a good guy, very wise, and he works. He's not lazy. I respect people who work, too. We get along fine. I don't barge in over there. I telephone before I go to call.

"In fact, when they have friends in, they always ask me to come, and they're always saying, 'you can't budge mafia out of her apartment.' But I do enjoy Sidney's friends. I like the kind of people he has around him, intelligent, creative, stimulating people. I guess if there is any snobishness in me, it's that I like to be with intelligent people."

Lena Horne is not the least snowed by her own success, but there are people and accomplishments in her life which give her satisfaction and pride:

"My children, first. They don't

hate me. We're friends. I think it's nice I've paid my bills. I've seen most of Europe, and I've lived abroad, and that was a good experience. I've had a big house, and now I have a small apartment and a small house.

"There's nothing I want. I have no unfulfilled ambitions. I loved working with Harry in Las Vegas; that's where he got the idea for this television special for us, but I really don't want to work in nightclubs any more. I want to make records and do a few television specials a year—three or four, that's enough. I don't need to be any more famous. I'm famous enough for me."

**SHE IS GRATEFUL** if she can help her family, when they need help. "They'd do the same for me. We all help one another."

She divides her time about evenly between here and the coast. Lennie Hayden spends more time on the coast since most of his work is out there.

"When I develop a strong attachment, it's likely to last forever," she said. "Lennie and I balance each other. I act on the spur of the moment. He doesn't. He's contemplative. I'm impulsive and emotional. We both love music and he taught me a lot. We don't do any sport things. I never learned how to play any games. I was on the stage when I was 16. Sometimes, me and Lennie go out to a range and shoot skeet.

"My life has settled into a better, calmer, more gentle kind of thing. I'm not happy by nature, maybe nobody is, I don't know, but I'm happier than I used to be. I'm not too optimistic for my people. Things are better, but they're still not good."

## Thalassa Cruso: Jolly green thumb

**H**ER NAME is Thalassa Cruso and she is the delight of everyone who has ever struggled with a dying African violet or a scraggly philodendron. Her weekly show, *Making Things Grow*, which premiered on Channel 11 last Thursday, will be seen on 13 subsequent Thursdays at 7:30 p.m.

In an age of over-specialization and complete dependence on expertise, Thalassa tackles the job of raising plants with the attitude that there is no such thing as a "green thumb." As she says, "The idea that it is necessary to possess a mysterious power in order to grow good plants is ridiculous. The only secret power the indoor horticulturist really needs is a true interest in plants."

**WITH HUMOR** and exasperation, Thalassa Cruso debunks some age-old ideas, introduces some brand-new and seemingly ridiculous ones in her weekly lesson in plant psychology, surgery and plain love.

She talks about the basic care of plants, how to prune, how to pinch, what plants are neglectable, best window-box bets, plant pests and growth through artificial lighting. She explains potting-on, an expression from her English childhood, that means replanting from a small pot to a larger one.

If you've ever wondered about

plastic bag humidity and the difference between the clay pot and the plastic pot, Thalassa will explain it. If you like to laugh, she will amuse you with her no-nonsense advice, such as that of tossing out hopeless, bedraggled plants that have outlived their usefulness.

A NATIVE of England, Miss Cruso came to this country in 1940 and was immediately confronted with the hazards of apartment heat.

"Gradually I learned what would and wouldn't grow under American apartment conditions. Gardening isn't an exact science, you know. I don't try to tell people what to do.

All I can do is show how things have succeeded for me. Of course, I show my failures, too. Nothing inspires confidence less than a gardener who has no failures."

Continuing, she says: "The point of my program is to show that it's not particularly difficult to grow plants. I never talk about anything that's expensive or beyond the capability of the apartment dweller.

"Even though there is no perfect way to approach gardening there are some basic ideas that must be understood and certain skills that must be acquired if you want to be successful — even in so simple a gardening venture as keeping a philodendron flourishing on a coffee table."

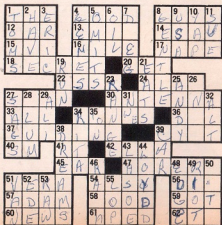
