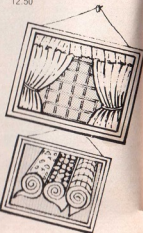

'Ten Who Dared' puts adventurers in spotlight

TEN OF THE WORLD'S greatest adventures will be re-enacted in the series *Ten Who Dared*, beginning Thursday on Channel 9. The series segments will be aired at 7 p.m. each Thursday.

Anthony Quinn, shown in the center of the cover picture, will be host and narrator for the series, and the actors chosen for each of the starring roles were selected for their physical resemblance to the characters they portray.

SHOWN ON THE cover are (clockwise from upper left) Henry Morton Stanley, first white explorer of the Congo River; Francisco Pizarro, conqueror of the Incas in Peru; Jedediah Smith, the first white man to cross America from the East Coast to California, and Charles Doughty, who dressed as an Arab to explore the deserts of Arabia in the 19th Century.

Others to be covered in the series are Christopher Columbus, who has been called the greatest explorer of them all, opening the series; Burke and Wills, first persons to cross the continent of Australia; Mary Kingsley, an Englishwoman who explored the west coast of Africa in 1893; Alexander von Humboldt, first explorer of Venezuela; Captain James Cook, who

made the first purely scientific voyage around the world, and Roald Amundsen, polar explorer.

The programs are termed docu-dramas, not plays. Although they are adventure stories, they also are precisely researched stories, filmed whenever possible in parts of the world where

the actual explorations took place. Locations included the Andes, the Sahara, the African jungle, the Arctic Circle and the central Australian plain.

The authentic dialog, taken from diaries, journals and letters written by the adventurers, is spoken in their native tongues.

AT VARIOUS TIMES during the three years it took to make *Ten Who Dared*, the crew was deported from one country (Zaire), inadvertently went into the hotel business in another (Sierra Leone), shared the mystery of a Polaroid camera with Australian aborigines, tried to ward off the diseases of a Congo swamp and sipped a local antidote for Andes altitude sickness that turned out to be cocaine.

Michael Latham was producer for the series. Directors included David McCallum (of *The Man from Uncle*), Emmy winner Tony Snowdon and the late Fred Burnley.

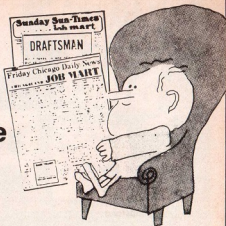
