QUESTIONS - ANSWERS

Q: Are there any trees I can plant in containers for my 15th floor windy balcony?

A: Most of the flowering trees (plum, almond, crab apple, honey locust, will grow in planters and don't mind the wind too much. If the winds are really harsh, however, you might consider

establishing a screen of some sort to protect your trees. Fencing or shrubbery can help a great deal. Other possible trees are crab apple, honey locust, Russian olive, or ginkgo.

Q: Can my outdoor potted geraniums be "seasoned over" so they will continue to bloom next spring?

A: One method is to move the pots into a cool garage. Dry them out gradually by watering them very lightly and eventually withholding water altogether. This allows them to go into a dormant

phase. In early spring, you can cut them back, put them in good light and begin to water them again slowly.

Q: Why are the leaves

of my aluminum plant turning brown at edges?

A: Either of two possibilities: You may be giving your plant too much harsh sunlight, or it may be receiving insufficient water.

HOLIDAY WINES

With Christmas almost upon us, selecting the right gifts can become a hassle and facing crowded stores leaves a lot to be desired.

Giving wine is an excellent alternative. There are wonderful neighborhood wine shops where you can browse for hours, picking and choosing the right wines at the right price. But first, you must know for whom you are buying.

If your friends are novices but interested in learning, start them off with two or three wines. For example, a nice selection could include Soave, a white wine with a hint of floweriness, and a Bardolino and Valpolicella, which are both light red wines. These three are best drunk young. Choose

Lambrusco, a mellow semi-sparkling red wine, a young Chianti, a familiar dry red or a fiftascati or Verdicchio, both well-known Italian wines.

The serious wine lover would appreciate an elegant Chianti Classico Riserva, full-bodied and fragrant with longevity to match wines anywhere in the world. Two other "big" and lesser-known reds are Barolo and Inferno. Include Pinot Grigio, a dry white light in texture, and Corvo Bianco which is a full-bodied wine.

Finally, for those who know and love wine. The truly great reds include Brunello di Montalcino, Torgiano Rosso Riserva and Amarone, all dry, rich and heavy, requiring many years in the bottle.

Spumante Brut, a dry sparkling wine fermented in the bottle, or Asti Spumante, Italy's famous sweet sparkling are special treats for one and all at Christmas.

Some of these can be purchased for as little as \$2, certainly an affordable price tag for a special gift.

Hobby Talk

MACRAME

Macrame - the hobby that is for men, women, and children. It's a hobby all about knots.

The Chinese people are believed to have been the first to use knots in ornamental form. The Japanese used knots for ceremonial purposes. The Egyptian tombs dating back 3500 years contained knots that are used in today's Macrame fascination. Navy men, for years, have been tying knots and making things fashioned from knots. The American Indians' clothes have always been fringed with various knots as a part of their fashion decor.

Anyone who can follow a few basic instructions can become involved in creating a Macrame piece of art. It may be a handbag you make for yourself, or a custom-made belt (either long or short), or a beautiful neck-piece. I recently saw a circular Macrame wall hanging in a museum and a huge wall hanging at a craft fair hung outside a building in the form of a flag. This Macrame was made with clothesline rope. You may select your materials from a vast array of ropes, yarns, cords, and threads (always bearing in mind the article you wish to create and the texture and weight of your material best suited to it.)

Macrame lends itself beautifully to vests, lampshades, placemats, vase covers, room dividers, wall hangings, belts, handbags, lower pots covers.
