

HOLLYWOOD—Angie Dickinson, the world's sexiest policewoman, just might get back to hubby Burt Bacharach, the songwriter and horse fancier, if she doesn't drown first.

"My producers do have me taking a lot of baths and showers," Miss Dickinson sighed. "I hate to tell you what I say when I have to take a bath. I'm very bad. I have a tremendous vocabulary.

'Pork Chop Hill'


Years after World War II and the Korean War, American movies got around to treating them with some real truth—hopefully this will happen again with the Vietnam War. "Pork Chop Hill" (12:23 a.m. Saturday on Channel 7) is, along with "Men in War" (and excepting "M*A*S*H," a comedy) the best of the Korean War movies. It captures the methodical realism of S.L.A. Marshall's book about a brave but rather senseless American effort near the end of the war to capture a hill. Gregory Peck is the commander, and among his troops are George Peppard, Rip Torn, James Edwards, Harry Guardino, Woody Strode, Martin Landau and Robert Blake. Lewis Milestone's direction may not be inspired—one inevitably looks back to his "All Quiet on the Western Front"—but he shows very well the confusion and comradeship of battle,
