What Ever Happened to Royalty?

A PORTRAIT of European aristocracy, focusing on kings that were and may never be again, will be presented on ABC News' What Ever Happened to Royalty? Monday, Sept. 9 [8-9 p. m., channel 7].

Against the once royal backdrop of Europe, where high mountain castles have become incongruities in today's classless society, What Ever Happened to Royalty? will tell the modern day story of majesty contained—of the heir to an empire that doesn't exist, of a king whose future



rests on the whim of a general, of a prince barred entrance to his own country, of a queen who remembers Victoria's court, and of an age when kings were truly kings.

It is the story of Prince Louis Ferdinand of Hohenzollern, grandson of the Kaiser and pretender to the throne of

a non-existent German empire; Otto of Hapsburg, heir to the Hapsburg throne and recently denied entry to his Austrian homeland; Don Juan of Spain, whose throne rests with the decision of Gen. Franco; Simeon of Bulgaria, son of the late king of Bulgaria and now living in exile

in Madrid; Victoria Eugenie, mother of Don Juan and granddaughter of England's Queen Victoria.

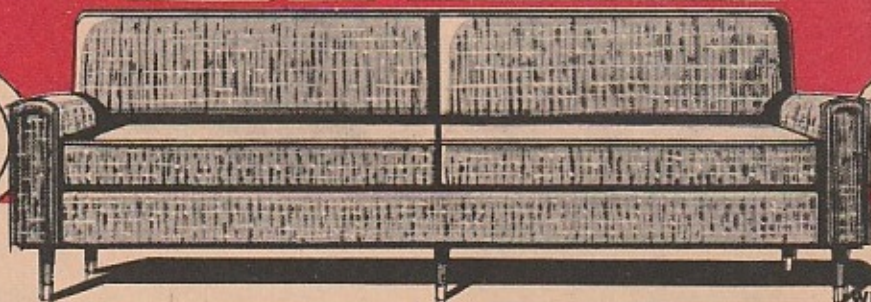

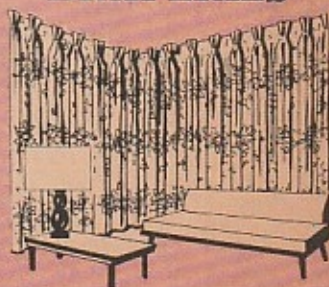
