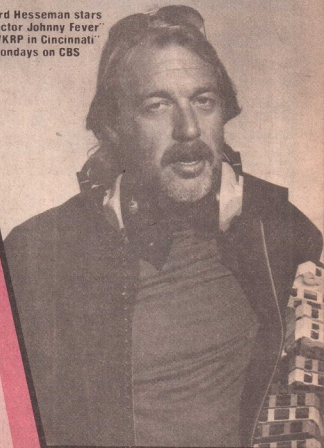

MEDICINE CHEST

I take several medicines at the same time to control my high blood pressure and Parkinsonism. Can any of these medicines cause dizziness when I get up from a chair? — L.H.

Both medicines could cause this problem. In addition, drugs classified as antipsychotics, antidepressants and central-nervous system depressants can cause dizziness. Normally your body would equalize your blood pressure through a reflex system when you are lying down, sitting or standing. These medicines interfere with this reflex system, allow the blood pressure to drop and cause dizziness. Your physician should be informed of this condition.

What factors does a physician consider in the selection of an antibiotic? — I.N.

There are many. Some of these include which antibiotic is most effective against the infecting bug; which antibiotic is most likely to reach or penetrate the infection site; which antibiotic is likely to cause the least side effects.

Is L-tryptophan a "natural" sedative? — B.S.

This essential amino acid is present in high concentrations in meat and fish. Results of several studies indicate that L-tryptophan can increase the amount of sleep a person obtains. The results of some other studies indicate it may also be useful in the treatment of depression. L-tryptophan is available in tablet form without a prescription in pharmacies and health food stores, or in a T-bone steak.

'EVERYONE NEEDS DESIGNERS'

So quotes Joan Kron in an article in New York magazine.

Here are some tips which will help you select the right designer:

Work with someone you like; you'll be spending a lot of time together and it should be a pleasant experience.

Be honest about how much money you plan to spend. If it's unrealistic, your designer will tell you. Your designer will ask many questions about the lifestyle of your family and you so that the end results will reflect your personality and not that of the designer's.

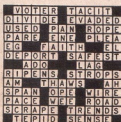
