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

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
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# Here Is TV's Plan for Election Night

BY BILL IRVIN

**W**HEN ELECTION returns start rolling in Tuesday night, they will set in operation what the three television networks claim is the most elaborate vote reporting machinery ever devised.

NBC regional centers in New York, Chicago, Atlanta, and San Francisco will receive returns from 50 states and the District of Columbia, channeling them in turn, via tele-

type, to RCA computers in the network's election central in New York. The computers will provide NBC's Electronic Vote Analysis [EVA] with projections of winners.

**CHET HUNTLEY** and **David Brinkley** will head NBC's election team, coordinating the over-all coverage. John Chancellor will report projections in significant contests, and Frank McGee will cover the 35 senatorial and 435 House races. The 25 gubernatorial contests will be reported individually. CBS is bringing its veteran newsman **Walter Cronkite** back into the picture for its election coverage, after Cronkite's replacement at the Democratic convention by **Bob Trout** and **Roger Mudd**.

CBS will use five "desks" in its coverage departing from its former regional plan when it assigned correspondents to groups of states. It will also use its **Vote Profile Analysis [V. P. A.]** again to indicate early winners and voting trends. The V. P. A. projections will be based on reports from 2,000 election precincts which will be fed into 7 million dollars worth of computing equipment, installed in the CBS Broadcast Center in New York.

**SPEARHEADING ABC's** "largest election task force" will be **Claire Boothe Luce**, former White House adviser **Arthur M. Schlesinger Jr.**, and **Sen. Sam Ervin [D., N. C.]**, who have been signed as "on-the-air consultants."

ABC's election anchor men will be **Howard K. Smith** and **Edward P. Morgan**. Also stationed at ABC's New York headquarters will be political editor **William H. Lawrence** and sectional reporters.

All three networks will collaborate with the Associated Press and United Press International in a special network election service for jointly gathering the vote totals.

**WGN-TV [channel 9]** and **W-G-N Radio** will have Illinois Senators **Paul H. Douglas** and **Everett M. Dirksen** as guest election analysts during the stations' election night coverage.

Channel 9 will have remote pickups from the headquarters of Gov. **Kerner** and **Charles Percy**, with **Lloyd Pettit**, **John M. Thompson**, **Bob Foster** and **Jack Taylor** as its anchor men. **Jack Brickhouse**, **Carl Greyson**, and **Greg Guinan** will anchor the radio coverage.

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

Sightseeing in Manhattan for the day, Debbie, star of *Karen of 90 Bristol Court* on NBC-TV (Mondays, 6:30-8 p. m., Channel 5), had just emerged from the Guggenheim Museum and was devouring with teen-age gusto a chocolate-toasted almond icecream pop when the former First Lady walked by. For anybody, it was exciting experience. For Debbie Watson, it was the culmination of her three-day visit to Manhattan.

"New York is simply terrific," said Debbie later on in the afternoon after leaving the Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts. "So much is happening here. I must live in New York some day. I'll get a real neat apartment and fix it up real cute and just see and do all the wonderful things New Yorkers can do daily. I wish there were a good place to surf here. I'll miss surfing a lot if I move here."

ALMOST 16 years old, Debbie Watson bubbles with endless energy and high spirits. Everything is fun to her. "If becoming a big star means not being able to have fun, then I don't want to become one," says Debbie. "I don't want to change."

Eventually, Debbie will change all by herself as a year or two passes. She will no longer want to roll down the car window to wave and shout to a group of 10-year-old boys. She also will not want to "bug" a track team from a high school working out in Central Park by saying, "If I

In her completely natural state, Debbie may be the greatest boost for "teen-agery" in years. In fact, she's completely capable of adding "lovable" to the teen-age image.
